DISCONNECT AND RECONNECT NOTICE

As of October 1, 2010, the Kansas Corporation Commission's Standard on Billing Practices will be effective as follows:

Bills are due on the 15th and delinquent on the 16th of each month. The Company will send notices of delinquent accounts. The Company must receive payment by the 20th or service will be disconnected. Reconnect charges shall consist of a Service Order Charge and a Central Office Charge. When service has been suspended, the company must receive payment for the original bill and the reconnect charge for service to be restored.

STATEMENT OF BILLING ERROR RIGHTS

This statement sets out your billing error rights with respect to telephone-billed purchases made using interstate 900 pay-per-call services that are billed to you through your Local Telephone Company.

The rights and obligations of you, the customer, and your Local Telephone Company and your Long Distance Company, who are billing entities, set out here, are provided under the Federal Telephone Disclosure and Dispute Resolution Act.

This is the procedure that you must follow to notify your Local Telephone Company of a billing error and the steps that we or your Long Distance Company must take in response to your notice:

You may provide notice of a billing error to your Local Telephone Company by telephone or in writing. If you write, you should:

- 1.) Give us your name or the customer's name, and telephone number to which the charge was billed.
- 2.) Tell us the date amount of the error, and the type of error you believe occurred.
- 3.) Tell us why you believe it was an error.

You should contact your Local Telephone Company first, since we have an agreement to receive billing error notifications from customers. You may provide a notice to your Long Distance Company instead, and they may ask you to contact us directly, and provide to you our name, mailing address, and business telephone number, even if they send your billing error notice to us.

A customer who orally communicates an allegation of a billing error is presumed to have provided sufficient notice to initiate a billing review.

You have the right to withhold payment of any disputed amount pending completion of our billing review, and any action to collect any disputed amount will be suspended pending completion of the billing review.

If it's determined that no billing error occurred, your rights and obligations are as follows:

We will transmit to you an explanation setting forth the reasons why it has been determined that there was no error. If there was an error – even a partial error or an error different than what you asserted, your account will be adjusted appropriately. If you request, we will provide a written explanation and copies of any documentary evidence of the customer indebtedness.

Your 900 service Provider (i.e., AT&T, Sprint, MCI, etc.) or your Long Distance Company will notify the provider of the service of the disposition of the billing error investigation and the reasons for that disposition.

Your Local Telephone Company will notify you in writing, normally with your billing statement, of the time when payment is due of that portion of the disputed amount that is determined not to be in error. Payment must be made in the normal course of billing or as otherwise provided, but not less than ten days after the request for payment is made.

Once your Local Telephone Company and your Long Distance Company, or you have complied with the FTC rule #308.7 (d) regarding a claim you make of a billing error, there is no further responsibility under that section if you continue to make substantially the same allegation. You cannot be charged for a billing review.

The provider of the 900 service, your Long Distance Company, or your Local Telephone Company may take action to collect the sum outstanding that is determined not to be the result of a billing error if you continue to withhold payment of the disputed amount once the billing review is completed.

Failure to pay the amount determined not to have been the result of a billing error may be reported to a credit reporting agency or subject you to collection action.

If either we, as your billing entity, or your Long Distance Company, a billing entity, fail to follow the billing and collection procedures prescribed by #308.7 of the Federal Trade Commission rule implementing the Federal Telephone Disclosure and Dispute Resolution Act, we are obligated to forfeit any disputed amount, up to \$50.00 per transaction.

USE OF TELEPHONE FOR DEBT COLLECTION PURPOSES

The Federal Communications Commission has received information that interstate telephone service is being used for collection of claimed debts in ways that are or may be violation of applicable tariffs of the telephone companies and criminal statutes. Practices alleged include calling at odd hours of the day or night; repeated calls; calls to friends, neighbors, relatives, employers and children; calls making a variety of threats; calls asserting falsely that credit rating will be hurt; calls falsely stating that legal process is about to be served; calls demanding payments for amounts not owed; calls to places of employment; and calls misrepresenting the terms and conditions of existing or proposed contracts. Although many of these calls are placed on a local basis, there is increasing indication that such improper practices also involve use of interstate toll and Wide Area Telephone Service (WATS).

Tariffs of the telephone companies forbid use of the telephone "... for a call or calls, anonymous or otherwise, if in a manner reasonably to be expected to frighten, abuse, torment, or harass another;" or for calls that "...interfere unreasonably with the use of the service by one or more other customers;" or calls for "...unlawful purpose." Upon violation of any of these conditions the telephone company can, by written notice, discontinue service "forthwith." These tariff regulations are filed with the Commission pursuant to Section 203 of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C., 203, and are binding on the telephone company and customer alike. Users of the telephone service are also subject to the enforcement proceedings provided for in Section 401 and 411 of the Communications Act. In addition to the loss of telephone service for violation of the tariffs, Section 223 of the Communications Act makes it a crime to use telephone in the District of Columbia or in interstate or foreign communications to make "repeated telephone calls, during which conversation ensues, solely to harass any person at the called number" or knowingly permit "others to use his telephone" for such purpose. Penalties for violation of Section 223 are a fine up to \$500.00 or six months' imprisonment, or both, 47 U.S.C. 223.

The Commission is concerned that some users of telephone service may be unaware of their obligations to refrain from using the service for abusive or harassing calls. It is also concerned that other users may be willfully and repeatedly violating the provision of the tariffs and the applicable statutes, and that the telephone companies are not adequately enforcing their tariffs. Accordingly, the Commission is issuing this Public Notice in order that the public may be informed of the requirements of law in this area and so that users may be alerted to their legal obligations in the use of the telephone and the penalties for failure to abide thereby.

Warning: Harassment by Telecommunication Device

(a) Harassment by telecommunication device is the use of:

(1) A telecommunications device to:

(A) Knowingly make or transmit any comment, request, suggestion, proposal, image, or text, which is obscene, lewd, lascivious, or indecent:

(B) Make or transmit a call, whether conversation ensues, with intent to abuse, threaten or harass any person at the receiving end:

(C) Make or transmit any comment, request, suggestion, proposal, image, or text with intent to abuse, threaten, or harass any person at the receiving end:

(D) Make or cause a telecommunications device to repeatedly ring or activate with intent to harass any person at the receiving end:

(E) Knowingly play any recording on a telephone, except recordings such as weather information or sports information when the number thereof is dialed, unless the person or group playing the recording shall be identified and state that it is a recording; or

(F) Knowingly permit any telecommunications device under one's control to be used in violation of this paragraph.

(2) Telefacsimile communication to send or transmit such communication to a court in the state of Kansas for a use other than court business, with no requirement of culpable mental state.

(b) Harassment by telecommunication device is a class A nonperson misdemeanor.

(c) Every telephone directory published for distribution to members of the public shall contain a notice setting forth a summary of the provisions of this section. Such notice shall be printed in type, which is no smaller than any other type on the same page and shall be preceded by the word "WARNING."

(d) As used in this section, "telecommunications device" includes telephones, cellular telephones, telefacsimile machines and any other electronic device which makes use of an electronic communication service, as defined in K.S.A. 22-2514, and amendments thereto.

(e) An offender who violates the provisions of this section may also be prosecuted for, convicted of, and punished for any other offense in K.S.A. 2021 Supp. 21-5508, 21-5509, 21-5510 or 21-6401*.

Low Income Program

Obscene & Harassing Calls

The law of the State of Kansas provides that:

Every person who shall by means of telephone communication:

- (a) make any comment, request, suggestion, or proposal which is obscene, lewd, lascivious, filthy, or indecent; or
- (b) make a telephone call, whether or not conversation ensues, with intent to abuse, threaten, or harass any person at the called number; or
- (c) make or cause the telephone of another repeatedly to ring, with intent to harass any person at the called number; or
- (d) make repeated telephone calls, during which conversation ensues, solely to harass any person at the called number; or
- (e) play any recording on a telephone, except recordings such as weather information or sports information, when the number there-of is dialed, unless the person or group playing the recording shall identify itself or himself and state that it is a recording; or
- (f) knowingly permit any telephone under his control to be used for any of the purposed mentioned here in shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall upon conviction thereof be punished by a fine of not more than two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500.00) or by confinement for not more than one year in the county jail, or by both such fine and confinement.

Kansas Telecommunications Access Program

The Kansas Telecommunications Access Program (TAP) is an equipment distribution program. The purpose of the program is to provide specialized telephones and other telecommunications devices to Kansans with disabilities who cannot use traditional home telephones. Based on state law, the program receives funds through the Kansas Universal Service Fund (KUSF) and is regulated by the Kansas Corporation Commission (KCC).

Kansas residents with existing telephone service and income below \$55,000 per year will qualify if they also have trouble hearing, seeing, speaking, remembering, walking, or holding a telephone.

Do Not Call/Telemarketing Annual Notification

The National Do Not Call list protects landline and wireless phone numbers. You can register your numbers on the National Do Not Call list at no cost by calling 1-888-382-1222 (voice) or (TTY: 1-866-290-4236). You must call from the phone number you wish to register. You can also register at donotcall.gov.

Telemarketers must remove your numbers from their call lists and stop calling you within 31 days from the date you register. Your numbers will remain on the list until you remove them or discontinue service there is no need to re-register numbers.

Under FCC rules, telemarketers calling your home must provide their name along with the name, telephone number, and address where their employer or contractor can be contacted. Telemarketing calls to your home are prohibited before 8 am or after 9 pm, and telemarketers are required to comply immediately with any do-not-call request you make during a call.

Whether you are on the National Do Not Call Registry or not, tell unwanted callers that you do not consent to the call and to put you on their internal do not call list. Make a record of the caller's number and when you made your request not to be called, and file a complaint with the FCC (<https://consumercomplaints.fcc.gov>) or the FTC (www.consumer.ftc.gov) if the caller does not comply with your request.

What is Kansas Relay?

Kansas Relay makes using the telephone possible for thousands of citizens and visitors who are deaf, hard of hearing, deafblind, or speech-disabled. It is a no-cost, completely confidential service that is available 24 hours a day.

How does Kansas Relay work?

The person dials the toll-free Kansas Relay number and gives the Communications Assistant the area code and number of the person receiving the call. Kansas Relay service has highly trained Communications Assistants who voice the typed comments by the TTY (text telephone) user and type the spoken comments by the other party back to the TTY user. Kansas Relay provides several options for people who do not use a standard telephone.
